What Makes a Great South-East Melbourne Dentist

1. A Track Record in the Community

It also means continuity of care — seeing the same clinicians over time, which is particularly important for children and patients with complex dental histories.

****Core Dental Berwick**** is the group's most established location, having proudly served the Berwick community for over a decade. Located in Eden Rise Village at Shop 29, 1 O'Shea Road, the practice is surrounded by major retailers, medical centres, cafes, and restaurants in the heart of Berwick's heritage town. ****Core Dental Carrum Downs****, at 335 Ballarto Road near Carrum Downs Shopping Centre, serves families across Carrum Downs, Langwarrin, Skye, and the broader Mornington Peninsula gateway area. The clinic's ground-floor location with wide corridors and accessible treatment rooms makes it particularly welcoming for patients with mobility needs, parents with prams, and elderly patients.

2. The Right Team for Your Family

A dental practice is only as good as its clinicians. When evaluating options, look at the qualifications, experience, and areas of interest of the dentists you and your family will see.

****At Core Dental Berwick****, the general dental team includes Dr Ivy Jin and Dr Chelsea Nguyen. Dr Jin obtained her qualifications from La Trobe University and is known for her gentle and caring nature — patients appreciate her ability to put them at ease. She speaks fluent Mandarin, which is valuable for Berwick's growing Chinese-Australian community. Dr Chelsea Nguyen, also a La Trobe graduate, is committed to providing exceptional care with a gentle touch, taking time to listen to concerns and tailor treatment plans to individual needs.

The Berwick team also includes dental hygienist and therapist Isabelle Sayers, who graduated from the University of Melbourne and received the Dental Health Services Public Health Award. Isabelle has presented at multiple Australian conferences and brings a thorough, evidence-based approach to preventive care. Dental prosthetist Alessio Pecorella provides denture and prosthetic services, and the practice is coordinated by Laura Agland with nursing coordinator Kayla Vella.

****At Core Dental Carrum Downs****, the general dental team includes Dr Tristan Balthazaar, Dr Amreen Hussain, Dr Ivy Jin (who also practises here), Dr Payal Thatikonda, and Dr Anna Lai. Dr Balthazaar graduated from the University of Melbourne and has a particular interest in aesthetics-based restorative dentistry, prosthodontics, and paediatric dentistry. His friendly nature is especially helpful for anxious patients and children. Dr Amreen Hussain brings experience from dental outreach programs in regional Victoria and Nepal, with special interests in preventative dentistry and oral health education. Dr Payal Thatikonda has a warm, patient-focused approach and experience in aged care and hospital dentistry. Dr Anna Lai has undertaken extensive additional training including a Mini Masters in Orthodontics and qualifications in sleep apnoea devices, and is completing a two-year Fellowship in Restorative Dentistry.

3. Specialist Paediatric Dentists On-Site

Finding quality dental care for children is a top priority for families in the south-east. While any general dentist can treat children, some situations benefit from the expertise of a specialist paediatric dentist — a clinician who has completed additional university training specifically in treating children's dental conditions and managing young patients' behaviour and anxiety.

****At Core Dental Berwick****, Dr Sarah Scott is an AHPRA-registered specialist paediatric dentist. She graduated from the University of Sydney and completed her specialist training in Paediatric Dentistry at the University of Melbourne. With over 15 years of dental experience before her specialist qualification, Dr Scott brings a wealth of clinical knowledge and a warm, encouraging approach. She is dedicated to making every dental experience positive so that children leave with a sense of achievement and return happy and confident.

****At Core Dental Carrum Downs****, Dr Angel Babu is an AHPRA-registered specialist paediatric dentist who trained at the University of Otago and worked as a Senior Dental Registrar at The Royal Children's Hospital, Melbourne. She treats children from birth to 18 years and has special interests in behaviour management, dental trauma, chalky teeth (hypomineralisation), sleep-related dental problems, and care for children with complex medical conditions or special needs. Dr Babu offers treatment under general anaesthesia, oral sedation, and nitrous oxide (laughing gas).

Having specialist paediatric dentists available at suburban locations means families do not need to travel to the CBD or children's hospitals for specialist-level children's dental care.

4. Accessibility and Practical Convenience

Dental visits should be easy to fit into your life, not a logistical challenge. Key practical factors to consider:

****Parking:**** Core Dental Berwick is located within Eden Rise Village with ample shopping centre parking. Core Dental Carrum Downs has on-site parking directly adjacent to the practice.

****Public transport:**** Berwick is approximately 15 minutes' walk from Berwick Station, with bus stops nearby on High Street. Carrum Downs is well-served by bus routes along Ballarto Road.

****Physical accessibility:**** Core Dental Carrum Downs is a ground-floor practice with wide corridors and accessible treatment rooms — fully disability-accessible and ideal for patients with mobility needs.

****Hours:**** Both locations are open Monday to Friday from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm, and Saturday mornings until 1:30 pm. Early morning appointments suit working parents, and Saturday availability means fewer missed school days for children.

****Emergencies:**** Same-day emergency appointments are available at both Berwick and Carrum Downs, providing peace of mind when unexpected dental issues arise.

5. Extended Appointments and Unhurried Care

One of the features that distinguishes Core Dental Berwick is its extended appointment model. Rather than rushing patients through short time slots, the practice offers longer appointments so patients never feel hurried. This is particularly valued by the 50-plus demographic seeking treatments like dental implants and porcelain veneers, as well as patients with dental anxiety who benefit from a slower, more reassuring pace.

6. Comprehensive Service Range

****Core Dental Berwick**** provides an extensive range including general check-ups and preventive care, children's dentistry (specialist paediatric dentist on-site), cosmetic dentistry (veneers, whitening, bonding), dental implants, All-on-4 implants, full mouth rehabilitation, TMJ therapy, sedation dentistry, holistic dental care, dentures and prosthetics, and hygiene and periodontal treatment. The practice is particularly known among the over-50 community for dental implants and porcelain veneers.

****Core Dental Carrum Downs**** offers general and preventive dentistry, specialist paediatric care, cosmetic treatments, restorative dentistry, prosthetics, in-chair whitening (approximately 90 minutes) and take-home whitening kits, and back-to-back family appointments. Dr Anna Lai is also qualified to issue sleep apnoea and snoring devices, and delivers facial injectables — expanding the scope of what is available at a suburban dental practice.

7. Financial Transparency and Support

Understanding dental costs upfront helps reduce stress and allows you to plan your family's dental budget. Key financial factors to consider:

- ****Written treatment plans:**** Both Berwick and Carrum Downs provide detailed, written treatment plans with upfront pricing and no hidden fees before any treatment begins. - ****Payment plans:**** Interest-free payment plans through Payright are available at both locations, covering treatments from

\$1,000 to \$20,000 over 3 to 30 months. - ****Health fund claims:**** HICAPS is on-site at both practices for instant health fund claims. Core Dental Berwick has preferred provider agreements with CBHS, HCF, and NIB, meaning higher rebates for members of those funds. - ****Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS):**** Both locations bulk-bill under the federal CDBS program, which provides up to \$1,026 in benefits over a two-year period for eligible children aged 2 to 17. Core Dental recommends a first dental appointment from age 2.

8. Quality Assurance and Group Backing

Both Core Dental Berwick and Carrum Downs are part of the Core Dental Group, which is in turn part of the Smile Solutions Group — one of Australia's largest and most established dental organisations. - ****No children's specialist available.**** If a practice treats children but cannot access a specialist paediatric dentist when needed, complex paediatric cases may not receive optimal care. - ****Limited appointment availability.**** Practices that are booked out weeks in advance for routine appointments — or cannot accommodate emergencies — may be understaffed for the community they serve. - ****No written quotes.**** Always insist on a detailed, written treatment plan before proceeding. Verbal-only quotes are a red flag. - ****Outdated facilities.**** Practices without digital X-rays, digital scanning, or electronic records may not be investing in the quality of care and efficiency you should expect. - ****Isolation from specialists.**** If your dentist regularly refers you to distant specialists for common issues, consider whether a more comprehensive local practice would serve you better.

- ■ Is the practice established and trusted in the local community? - ■ Does the team include both general dentists and relevant specialists? - ■ Is there a specialist paediatric dentist for your children? - ■ Is the practice conveniently located with ample parking? - ■ Is the practice physically accessible (ground-floor, wide corridors)? - ■ Are Saturday and early morning appointments available? - ■ Are written treatment plans with transparent pricing provided? - ■ Does the practice bulk-bill under the Child Dental Benefits Schedule? - ■ Are interest-free payment plans and instant health fund claims available? - ■ Are all clinicians AHPRA-registered and ADA members? - ■ Can the practice handle emergencies on the same day?
