What Are All-on-4 Dental Implants?

All-on-4 is a full-arch teeth replacement system that uses just four strategically placed titanium implants to support a complete set of teeth for an entire jaw. The name comes from the fact that a full arch of teeth is secured by four implants, making the procedure more accessible than traditional implants (which may require one implant per tooth).

The procedure is completed under general anaesthetic as day surgery, and most patients leave with a functional set of teeth within 1-2 days. Some Medicare rebates may apply.

All-on-4 implants offer significant advantages over traditional full dentures:

- **Permanent and fixed** - no removal, no adhesives, no slipping - **Natural look and feel** - designed to match your facial structure and preferences - **Preserves jawbone** - implants stimulate bone, preventing the bone loss that dentures cannot stop - **Easier to eat** - enjoy virtually any food with confidence - **Improved speech** - no denture movement affecting pronunciation - **Long-lasting** - with proper care, implants can last a lifetime

The All-on-4 Process at Caroline Springs

Step 1: Comprehensive Assessment

Core Dental Caroline Springs is equipped with on-site CBCT 3D imaging - our 3D cone beam computed tomography scanner allows your dentist to assess your bone structure, nerve pathways, and sinus anatomy with remarkable precision before treatment begins. This level of planning is critical to the success of All-on-4 treatment.

Step 2: Treatment Planning

Your dentist will design a customised implant plan based on your 3D scan. You will receive a full, written treatment plan and cost estimate before committing to any procedure.

Step 3: Surgery

All-on-4 surgery is performed under general anaesthetic at a day surgery facility. Four titanium implants are placed at precise angles to maximise contact with available bone - including areas toward the back of the jaw where bone density is typically greater.

Step 4: Immediate Temporary Teeth

On the same day as surgery, a temporary fixed bridge is attached to your implants so you leave with functional teeth. You will follow a soft diet during the healing period.

Step 5: Final Restoration

After 3-6 months of healing, your permanent, custom-crafted final bridge is fitted - the long-term result of your full-arch restoration.

Frequently Asked Questions

**How long does All-on-4 take at Core Dental Caroline Springs?*

From initial consultation to final prosthesis, the full process typically takes 3 to 6 months. A temporary set of teeth is placed on the day of surgery so you leave with a functional smile.

**Is bone grafting required for All-on-4?*

Not always. The angled placement technique used in All-on-4 is specifically designed to work with available bone, frequently avoiding the need for grafts. Your 3D CBCT scan assessment will determine whether any bone augmentation is needed in your case.

**What happens if an implant fails?*

Implant failure, while uncommon, can occur. Your treatment plan includes a warranty discussion and contingency approach. All surgery is coordinated through our specialist CSSC partners who have extensive experience managing complex cases and revisions.
