Child Dental Benefits Schedule - Bulk Billing

Core Dental Glenferrie will bulk bill under the Australian Government's Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS) from day one. Eligible children aged 2-17 can receive essential dental care including check-ups, X-rays, cleaning, fissure sealants, fillings, and extractions at no out-of-pocket cost.

Check eligibility through myGov (Medicare) or call Services Australia on 132 011.

Frequently Asked Questions

****At what age should my child first see a dentist?*** The Australian Dental Association recommends a child's first dental visit by their first birthday or within 6 months of their first tooth erupting. Early visits help your child develop a positive relationship with the dentist and allow early identification of any concerns.

****Do you bulk bill children under the Child Dental Benefits Schedule?*** Yes - Core Dental accepts CDBS, providing up to \$1,026 over 2 years for eligible children aged 2 to 17. Eligibility is based on receiving relevant Australian Government payments. Check via MyGov (Medicare) or call us for guidance.

****What if my child is anxious about the dentist?*** Our entire team is trained in gentle, patient-centred care for children. We use child-friendly language, explanation-before-action techniques, and a warm, welcoming environment. Happy gas (nitrous oxide) is available for children who need extra reassurance.

****How often should children have dental check-ups?*** Every 6 months is recommended for most children. Some children with higher decay risk or orthodontic monitoring needs may benefit from more frequent visits.
