The Wedding Smile Timeline: When to Start What

The key to achieving your best smile for your wedding is starting early enough for the treatment you want. Different treatments require different lead times. Here is a practical timeline:

Twelve Months Before the Wedding

This is the ideal starting point — particularly if you are considering alignment (Invisalign), porcelain veneers, or any treatment that involves multiple stages.

****What can be started at twelve months:****

- ****Invisalign clear aligners**** — most Invisalign cases take six to eighteen months, depending on complexity. Starting twelve months out gives sufficient time for moderate to complex alignment, with time to spare for refinement. Core Dental Group's Blue Diamond Provider status means even complex cases are managed with confidence - ****Comprehensive dental assessment**** — a full examination, digital radiographs, and professional cleaning. This is the foundation. Any decay, gum disease, or structural issues should be identified and addressed before cosmetic treatment begins - ****Gum health treatment**** — if you have gum disease, inflammation, or recession, addressing it now ensures your gums are healthy and stable before any cosmetic work. Healthy gums are the frame for a beautiful smile - ****Treatment planning for veneers**** — if porcelain veneers are being considered, the consultation, smile design, and planning process can begin. For complex cases, referral to the Smile Solutions Group's specialist cosmetic team may be appropriate

****Why starting early matters:**** Time is your greatest ally. Starting at twelve months gives you the flexibility to spread treatment across multiple appointments, allows for healing and settling between stages, and eliminates the stress of rushing to meet a deadline. It also means you can spread the financial investment across the year rather than facing a single large expense.

Six Months Before the Wedding

Six months is still a good window for many treatments, though some options begin to narrow.

****What can be achieved in six months:****

- ****Invisalign for mild to moderate cases**** — simple alignment concerns, minor crowding, or closing small gaps may be achievable within a six-month treatment window. Invisalign Go (for anterior alignment) is specifically designed for shorter treatment durations - ****Composite bonding**** — can be completed in a single appointment at any time, but planning it into your six-month timeline allows time for any preliminary treatment (whitening, cleaning) and ensures you are not rushing - ****Porcelain veneers**** — for straightforward cases, the full veneer process (consultation, preparation, fabrication, bonding) can be completed within six months - ****Professional whitening**** — in-chair whitening provides immediate results, while take-home whitening trays produce gradual brightening over two to four weeks. Both can be timed precisely to your wedding - ****Fillings and crown replacement**** — any visible fillings that are discoloured or deteriorating can be replaced with tooth-coloured restorations

Three Months Before the Wedding

At three months, the focus shifts to cosmetic refinement and final preparations.

****What can be achieved in three months:****

- ****Professional whitening**** — this is the sweet spot for whitening. In-chair whitening followed by a take-home maintenance kit ensures your teeth are at their brightest and the result is stabilised before the wedding - ****Composite bonding**** — chips, gaps, and minor imperfections can be addressed in a single appointment - ****Final hygiene appointment**** — a professional clean to ensure your teeth and gums are in peak condition - ****Mouthguard assessment**** — if you grind your teeth at night and have recently had cosmetic work, a nightguard protects your investment from stress-related clenching (wedding planning stress is real)

One Month Before the Wedding

At one month, the goal is polish and confidence.

****What can be achieved in one month:****

- ****Touch-up whitening**** — a single in-chair session or a few days of take-home whitening to boost brightness to its peak - ****Final check-up**** — a quick examination to confirm everything is in perfect condition - ****Minor composite bonding touch-ups**** — if any small adjustments are needed - ****Emergency repairs**** — a chip, a lost filling, or any last-minute concern is addressed promptly

The Week Before

- Avoid red wine, coffee, dark berries, and other strong staining agents — particularly if you have recently whitened - Continue your normal oral hygiene routine — brush twice daily, floss daily - Do not try a new whitening product you have never used before — this is not the time for experiments - If anything feels wrong — pain, sensitivity, a rough edge — call the practice immediately. Do not wait until after the wedding

Treatment Options for Your Wedding Smile

Professional Teeth Whitening

Whitening is the most popular pre-wedding dental treatment — and for good reason. It provides the most dramatic visual improvement for the least invasive procedure.

****In-chair whitening**** uses a high-concentration whitening gel applied by your dentist, activated by a special light, to brighten teeth by several shades in a single appointment of approximately sixty to ninety minutes. Results are immediate and visible.

****Take-home whitening**** uses custom-fitted trays and a lower-concentration whitening gel that you wear at home — typically for thirty minutes to an hour each day over two to four weeks. The results build gradually and can be precisely controlled.

****Combination approach**** — many patients achieve the best results with an in-chair treatment followed by take-home maintenance. The in-chair session provides the initial brightening, and the take-home trays maintain and enhance the result in the weeks leading up to the wedding.

****Timing tip:**** Complete your whitening at least two weeks before the wedding. This allows any temporary sensitivity to resolve and the final shade to stabilise.

Porcelain Veneers

For patients seeking a more significant transformation — correcting chips, gaps, discolouration, or uneven teeth — porcelain veneers offer a permanent, stunning result. Core Dental Glenferrie is part of the Smile Solutions Group, which developed the world-first Same Day Porcelain Veneers.

Porcelain veneers require a lead time of at least six to eight weeks for the full process (consultation, preparation, laboratory fabrication, bonding). For complex cases or cases involving multiple teeth, allow three to six months.

Composite Bonding

Composite bonding is the fastest cosmetic dental treatment — completed in a single appointment, with no laboratory wait. It is ideal for:

- Repairing a chipped front tooth - Closing a small gap between teeth - Evening out uneven tooth edges
- Improving the shape of one or two teeth

For couples on a tight timeline, composite bonding can transform a smile in a single visit, often in under two hours.

Invisalign Clear Aligners

Straight teeth photograph beautifully. If alignment is your primary concern, Invisalign offers a discreet, removable, and effective solution. With Core Dental Group's Blue Diamond Provider status and experience across thousands of cases, even complex alignment can be managed — provided you start early enough.

For wedding timelines, Invisalign is best started at least twelve months before the date for moderate cases, or six months for mild cases. Invisalign aligners are removable, so they will not interfere with engagement photos, wedding tastings, or pre-wedding events.

General and Preventive Care

Sometimes the most important pre-wedding dental treatment is the simplest: a thorough check-up, professional cleaning, and resolution of any outstanding dental issues. A cavity that has been ignored for months, a filling that has been deteriorating, or gum inflammation that causes redness and puffiness at the gum line — addressing these basics can make a significant difference to how your smile looks and feels on the day.

Couple and Bridal Party Packages

The best wedding photographs capture genuine emotion, not posed smiles - ****Communicate with your photographer**** — a good wedding photographer knows how to capture your smile at its best. Let them know if there is a side you prefer or an angle you are more comfortable with - ****Relax**** — anxiety and tension show in photographs. If your dental concerns have been addressed, you will smile more freely — and that confidence will be visible in every image
