\*\*CEREC process:\*\* 1. Digital iTero scan of the prepared tooth — no physical impressions 2. Computer-aided crown design — reviewed by your dentist 3. Crown milled from high-grade ceramic block in ~15–20 minutes in our practice 4. Crown fitted, adjusted, and permanently cemented — same appointment

## ## Dental Bridges: Replacing Missing Teeth

A dental bridge provides a fixed, permanent replacement for one or more missing teeth, using crowns on adjacent teeth or implants to anchor the artificial replacement (pontic).

Bridges at Core Dental Caroline Springs restore chewing function, prevent adjacent teeth from drifting, and maintain the appearance of your smile.

**\*\*Bridge treatment:\*\*** 2 appointments over 2–3 weeks.

## ## CEREC Same-Day Ceramic Crowns at Core Dental

Core Dental practices equipped with CEREC technology offer patients the option of having a permanent ceramic crown designed, milled and fitted in a single appointment, eliminating the traditional two-visit process with a temporary crown.

### ### How CEREC Works: The 5-Step Process

**\*\*Step 1: Digital Impression\*\*** Instead of traditional impression putty, your dentist uses an optical intraoral scanner to capture a precise 3D digital image of the prepared tooth and surrounding teeth. The scan takes just a few minutes and is far more comfortable than traditional impressions.

**\*\*Step 2: CAD Design\*\*** Using CEREC software, your dentist designs the custom crown on screen, specifying the exact shape, contacts and bite relationship. The design can be refined to match your natural tooth shape and fit precisely within your bite.

**\*\*Step 3: Milling\*\*** The digital design is transmitted to the CEREC milling unit, which carves the crown from a solid ceramic block in approximately 15-20 minutes. The ceramic material is available in a wide range of tooth shades to match your natural teeth.

**\*\*Step 4: Glazing and Characterisation\*\*** Once milled, the crown may be glazed or further characterised to achieve optimal aesthetics and a lifelike surface texture before being placed.

**\*\*Step 5: Fitting and Bonding\*\*** The completed crown is tried in your mouth, any minor adjustments made, and the crown permanently bonded to your tooth. The entire process from preparation to placement is completed in a single appointment of 1.5-2.5 hours.

### ### Benefits of CEREC Same-Day Crowns

### ### Is CEREC Suitable for Your Crown?

CEREC is suitable for most crown cases, particularly on posterior (back) teeth. For anterior (front) teeth requiring exceptional aesthetics, a laboratory-fabricated crown from our ceramist team may produce superior cosmetic outcomes in complex cases. Your dentist will advise on the most appropriate approach at your consultation.

### ## Frequently Asked Questions

**\*\*How much do crowns cost at Core Dental Caroline Springs?\*** CEREC same-day crowns from ,600. Lab-fabricated crowns from ,400. Written quotes provided at consultation. HICAPS on-site for instant health fund claiming. Call (03) 9363 7888 for a specific estimate.

**\*\*Can I get a crown done in one day at Caroline Springs?\*** Yes — Core Dental Caroline Springs has CEREC technology for eligible cases. This means one appointment, no temporary crown, and a permanent ceramic crown fitted the same day. Ask at your consultation whether CEREC is appropriate for your tooth.

**\*\*What is the 3D CBCT imaging used for with crowns?\*** CBCT 3D imaging gives a three-dimensional view of the tooth, root, surrounding bone, and nearby structures. For complex crown cases — particularly where root treatment or implant planning is involved — this level of detail improves diagnostic accuracy and treatment planning significantly.

**\*\*Do you offer crown consultations in Arabic or Farsi?\*** Yes — Dr Sherin Gad speaks Arabic and Dr Shakiba Askary speaks Farsi. Consultations in your preferred language are available. Let us know when you book.

**\*\*Is a dental implant or a crown better for a damaged back tooth?\*** If the tooth can be saved and is structurally sound, a crown is usually preferred — preserving the natural root, which maintains jawbone density and adjacent tooth position. If the tooth is unsalvageable, an implant (with an implant crown) is typically the best long-term replacement. Your dentist will assess and discuss both options.
