Our northern Melbourne practice features **CEREC same-day crown technology** — letting eligible patients walk in with a damaged tooth and walk out with a permanent crown fitted on the same day.

CEREC Same-Day Crowns — Available at Epping

Core Dental Epping is one of a select number of Core Dental practices offering **CEREC same-day crown technology**. CEREC (Chairside Economical Restoration of Esthetic Ceramics) combines digital scanning, computer-aided design, and in-practice milling to fabricate a permanent porcelain crown in a single appointment — no temporary crown, no second visit.

CEREC crown process: 1. Digital scan of the prepared tooth — no physical impressions 2. Computer-aided design of the crown (patient can view the design) 3. Crown milled from high-quality ceramic block in approximately 15–20 minutes 4. Crown fitted, adjusted, and cemented — all in one appointment

CEREC crowns from ,600 at Core Dental Epping. Written quote provided before treatment begins.

CEREC crowns are suitable for most posterior (back) teeth. Your dentist will advise whether CEREC is appropriate for your specific case.

Standard Lab-Fabricated Crowns

For cases where CEREC is not indicated — including front teeth requiring highly customised aesthetics, or complex restorations — we also provide traditional lab-fabricated crowns over two appointments (2–3 weeks apart).

Dental Bridges: Replacing Missing Teeth

A dental bridge provides a fixed, non-removable replacement for one or more missing teeth — using crowns on adjacent teeth (or implants) to anchor the artificial replacement tooth (pontic).

Bridge benefits: - Prevents adjacent teeth from drifting - Prevents jawbone loss in the gap area - Restores normal chewing and speaking - Natural-looking result that blends with your smile

Bridge treatment at Core Dental Epping typically requires two appointments over 2–3 weeks.

Crown and bridge treatments are commonly covered by private health insurance extras. **HICAPS on-site** for instant claiming. **Payright interest-free payment plans** (up to 30 months) available for treatment packages. Eligible children can access CDBS bulk billing for covered services.

CEREC Same-Day Ceramic Crowns at Core Dental

Core Dental practices equipped with CEREC technology offer patients the option of having a permanent ceramic crown designed, milled and fitted in a single appointment, eliminating the traditional two-visit process with a temporary crown.

How CEREC Works: The 5-Step Process

****Step 1: Digital Impression**** Instead of traditional impression putty, your dentist uses an optical intraoral scanner to capture a precise 3D digital image of the prepared tooth and surrounding teeth. The scan takes just a few minutes and is far more comfortable than traditional impressions.

****Step 2: CAD Design**** Using CEREC software, your dentist designs the custom crown on screen, specifying the exact shape, contacts and bite relationship. The design can be refined to match your natural tooth shape and fit precisely within your bite.

****Step 3: Milling**** The digital design is transmitted to the CEREC milling unit, which carves the crown from a solid ceramic block in approximately 15-20 minutes. The ceramic material is available in a wide range of tooth shades to match your natural teeth.

****Step 4: Glazing and Characterisation**** Once milled, the crown may be glazed or further characterised to achieve optimal aesthetics and a lifelike surface texture before being placed.

****Step 5: Fitting and Bonding**** The completed crown is tried in your mouth, any minor adjustments made, and the crown permanently bonded to your tooth. The entire process from preparation to placement is completed in a single appointment of 1.5-2.5 hours.

Is CEREC Suitable for Your Crown?

CEREC is suitable for most crown cases, particularly on posterior (back) teeth. For anterior (front) teeth requiring exceptional aesthetics, a laboratory-fabricated crown from our ceramist team may produce superior cosmetic outcomes in complex cases. Your dentist will advise on the most appropriate approach at your consultation.

Frequently Asked Questions

****How much do crowns cost at Core Dental Epping?*** CEREC same-day crowns from ,600. Standard lab-fabricated crowns from ,400. Written quotes provided before any treatment proceeds. HICAPS on-site for instant health fund claiming. Call (03) 9401 4622 for a specific estimate.

****Can I get a crown fitted in one day at Core Dental Epping?*** Yes — Core Dental Epping has CEREC technology to design and fabricate a permanent ceramic crown in a single appointment for eligible cases. This eliminates the need for a temporary crown and a second visit. Ask at your consultation whether CEREC is appropriate for your tooth.

****How long does a dental crown last?*** With proper care, crowns typically last 10–15 years or longer. Regular 6-monthly check-ups allow your dentist to assess crown condition and address any issues early.

****What should I do if my crown chips or falls out?*** Call us immediately on (03) 9401 4622 or 13 13 16. A loose or fallen crown is a dental emergency — the exposed tooth can be sensitive and at risk. We hold daily emergency appointment slots for urgent situations.

****Is a crown better than an extraction for a badly decayed tooth?*** In most cases, preserving a natural tooth with a crown is preferable to extraction. Natural tooth roots maintain jawbone density and adjacent tooth position in a way that implants or bridges cannot fully replicate. Your dentist will assess whether the tooth can be saved with a crown, or whether other options are more appropriate.
