What Are Dental Implants?

A dental implant is a small titanium screw that is placed into the jawbone to act as an artificial tooth root. Once the implant integrates with the bone (a process called osseointegration, typically taking 3-6 months), a custom-made crown is attached on top to create a natural-looking, permanently fixed replacement tooth.

Implants are: - ****Permanent and fixed**** - they do not come out like dentures - ****Natural-looking**** - custom-crafted to match your existing teeth - ****Bone-preserving**** - they stimulate the jawbone, preventing the bone loss that follows tooth loss - ****Long-lasting**** - with proper care, implants can last a lifetime - ****Easy to maintain**** - brush and floss like natural teeth

Are You a Candidate for Implants?

Most healthy adults with sufficient bone volume are suitable candidates for dental implants. Factors that affect suitability include:

- Bone density and volume (bone grafting may be required if bone loss has occurred) - Overall health and medical history - Smoking (significantly increases failure risk - quitting is strongly recommended) - Gum health

Frequently Asked Questions

How long do dental implants last? With proper oral hygiene and regular professional care, dental implants can last 15 years or more - many patients enjoy decades of trouble-free use. The titanium implant itself is designed as a permanent fixture; the crown on top may need replacement after 10 to 15 years.

Is the implant procedure painful? Dental implant placement is performed under local anaesthetic and is generally well-tolerated. Some soreness and swelling for a few days after surgery is normal and managed with over-the-counter pain relief. Sleep dentistry (IV sedation) is available for particularly anxious patients.

How long does the full implant process take? A conventional implant involves placement, followed by 3 to 6 months of healing (osseointegration) before the final crown is attached. Same-day or immediate implants are available in selected cases. Your dentist will provide a timeline at your assessment.

Am I a suitable candidate for implants? Most adults with good general health are suitable candidates. Adequate bone density is required, though bone grafting can build this up where needed. Smokers face a higher risk of implant failure and are advised to quit before treatment. A full clinical assessment - including imaging - determines suitability.
