Why regular dental check-ups matter in a growing community

Melbourne's western growth corridor has a large and rapidly expanding population, many of them young families putting down roots for the first time. Having access to quality local dental care matters, and preventive care matters most of all.

Tooth decay and gum disease are the two most common chronic health conditions in Australia. They tend to develop quietly, often without pain or any visible signs, until they've reached a point where treatment becomes more involved. Regular check-ups at Core Dental Group Wyndham allow us to catch problems while they're still manageable: a filling rather than a root canal, early gum treatment rather than periodontics, careful monitoring rather than emergency intervention.

For most patients, we recommend check-ups every six months. Some people benefit from coming in more often, including those with active gum disease, a higher rate of decay, diabetes, dry mouth, or orthodontic appliances.

What does a dental check-up at Core Dental Group Wyndham include?

Systematic tooth examination

Your dentist examines every tooth for signs of decay, cracking, wear, and erosion. We use intraoral cameras to give you a clear view of what we're seeing, so the examination is transparent and easy to follow.

Gum health assessment

We measure gum pocket depths, check for signs of bleeding and inflammation, assess bone support levels, and monitor gum disease risk. Gum disease is the leading cause of tooth loss in Australian adults, and regular monitoring is one of the most effective tools we have for prevention and early treatment.

Oral cancer screening

We examine all soft tissues in the mouth, including gums, tongue, cheeks, lips, palate, and the floor of the mouth, for any signs of abnormality. Oral cancer detected early has significantly better treatment outcomes than oral cancer found at a later stage.

Review of existing dental work

Fillings, crowns, bridges, and other restorations are checked for wear, failure, and signs of secondary decay. We'll let you know if anything needs attention before it turns into a bigger issue.

Dental X-rays

Taken as clinically appropriate and based on your individual risk profile. We use digital X-rays, which produce less radiation than traditional film and provide instant, high-resolution images. X-rays help us detect decay between teeth, assess bone levels, and examine areas that aren't visible during a clinical examination.

Bite and jaw assessment

We check for signs of teeth grinding (bruxism), clenching, and jaw joint dysfunction, all of which can cause progressive tooth damage when left unmanaged.

Oral hygiene review

We talk through your home care routine and offer personalised, practical advice on how to get more out of it.

What does a professional dental clean include?

Tartar removal (scaling)

Tartar forms when plaque hardens on tooth surfaces. It builds up over time regardless of how diligently you brush, particularly along the gumline and in areas between teeth that are harder to reach. Tartar can only be removed professionally. We use ultrasonic scalers and fine hand instruments to remove tartar from all surfaces, including below the gumline.

Subgingival cleaning

Where gum disease or deeper pockets are present, we clean beneath the gum tissue to remove bacterial deposits and smooth root surfaces. This is the key step in managing and preventing gum disease from progressing further.

****Polish and stain removal****

We polish teeth to remove surface staining from coffee, tea, red wine, and other dietary sources.

****Fluoride treatment****

A professional fluoride application strengthens enamel and provides added protection against decay. It's recommended for most patients and especially beneficial for children.

****Oral hygiene instruction****

Personalised guidance on brushing technique, interdental cleaning, and flossing, tailored to what we observe during your examination and clean.

Your dental records, including clinical notes, X-rays, and treatment history, are accessible across all Core Dental Group and Smile Solutions locations via CareStack. Your history follows you across the group, so you never need to start from scratch.

When check-up findings indicate that specialist care is needed, we refer patients to the Collins Street Specialist Centre in Melbourne's CBD, also part of the Smile Solutions Group. Specialists there cover periodontics, endodontics, oral surgery, and prosthodontics. Your Wyndham dentist coordinates the referral and manages your ongoing care, keeping everything connected.

All Core Dental Group clinics operate to the same protocols and quality standards.

The Wyndham clinic is easy to reach from across Melbourne's western growth corridor.

By car, it's close to the Princes Freeway/Westgate Freeway and Western Ring Road, with free parking on site. By train, the Werribee line runs regular services between Werribee Station and the Melbourne CBD.

Family dental care for the western growth corridor

Core Dental Group Wyndham is registered under the Medicare Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS). Eligible children aged 0–17 may be able to access check-ups, cleans, and other preventive treatments under this scheme. Ask our team whether your child qualifies.

****Private health insurance****

Check-ups and cleans fall under "preventive dental" or "general dental" in most private health fund extras policies. Core Dental Group accepts all major health funds, and our team can clarify your entitlements before your appointment.
