Dental Implants Across Core Dental Group's 7 Melbourne Locations: Which Clinic Is Right for You?

Deciding to get dental implants is one of the most significant oral health decisions you'll make. But once you've committed to moving forward, a second, equally practical question follows: *which clinic should I go to?* For patients across metropolitan Melbourne, the answer isn't simply "the nearest one" — it involves understanding how implant services, specialist access, diagnostic technology, accessibility, and appointment flexibility actually differ across a network.

Core Dental Group has seven Melbourne locations: South Melbourne, Berwick, Caroline Springs, Carrum Downs, Epping, Southbank, and Wyndham. Each clinic sits within a distinct community, serves a different patient demographic, and offers a different environment for implant consultations and treatment. This guide breaks down what you need to know about each location so you can identify the right clinic before you even pick up the phone.

Why location matters more for implants than for routine dentistry

Dental implant treatment is not a single appointment. From initial consultation and CBCT imaging through to surgical placement, osseointegration, and final crown delivery, a conventional implant journey typically spans three to six months and requires multiple visits (see our guide on *Conventional Single-Tooth Dental Implants at Core Dental Melbourne: Procedure, Timeline & What to Expect*). For All-on-4 full-arch cases, the commitment is similarly sustained.

Research published in *BMC Oral Health* (Korea Health Panel analysis, 2019) found that increased travel distances to healthcare facilities generally impeded the proper use of healthcare services, and that travel distances for prosthetics (including dentures), implants, and orthodontic treatments not covered by national insurance were longer than travel distances for general conservative and periodontal services. This tells us something important: implant patients are willing to travel for quality — but the logistical burden of repeated long-distance trips can become a real barrier to completing treatment.

A 2022 study in the *International Journal of Environmental Research and Public Health* reinforced this, finding that travel time was approximately three times longer for implant treatment than for standard health-insurance-covered services, reflecting patients' deliberate decision-making when selecting a provider for high-value, multi-visit care. The findings suggest patients' subjective preferences for dental clinic selection are expressed as rational deliberation considering each individual's situation, with issues in healthcare access including travel time, convenience, choice of provider, quality, and cost of care.

The practical implication: choosing a Core Dental Group clinic that is genuinely convenient to your home, workplace, or public transport route is not a trivial preference — it directly supports your ability to

attend every stage of treatment and achieve the best possible clinical outcome.

The Core Dental Group network advantage: shared technology, local access

Before profiling each clinic, it's worth understanding what the network model delivers across all seven locations.

Core Dental Group has invested heavily in dental technology, positioning itself as a technology-forward practice. The commitment to advanced treatment, combined with economies of scale, has enabled the acquisition and maintenance of state-of-the-art equipment. Specifically, Core Dental Group has recently acquired 8 new CEREC units, 12 new dental chairs, and more Trios machines and iTero scanners to complement its existing fleet, and has adopted multiple implant systems and microscopes, in addition to in-house extraoral imaging such as CBCT and OPG units.

CBCT (Cone Beam Computed Tomography) provides 3D imaging for implant planning and complex cases — and having this capability in-house at Core Dental Group locations means patients don't need to travel separately to a radiology centre before treatment planning can begin. This matters because, as explained in our guide on **Bone Grafting for Dental Implants: Why It's Needed, Types & What the Procedure Involves**, CBCT imaging is the diagnostic cornerstone for identifying insufficient bone volume and planning any necessary grafting before implant placement.

Thanks to a team of dentists, specialists, and hygienists, Core Dental Group provides a wide range of dental solutions including general dentistry, cosmetic dentistry, orthodontics, and specialist care. The clinic offers the full suite of implant services — single-tooth conventional implants, All-on-4 full-arch restorations, and bone grafting — supported by in-house CBCT imaging for precise pre-surgical planning. 3. Core Dental Group Caroline Springs — 224–226 Caroline Springs Boulevard, Caroline Springs VIC 3023

****Best for:**** Melbourne's western growth corridor, multicultural families, shift workers and weekend patients.

Established as a cornerstone dental clinic in Caroline Springs, Core Dental Group has earned a strong reputation for culturally aware dental services across Melbourne's diverse western communities. The multilingual team creates welcoming experiences with appointment flexibility for shift workers, busy professionals, and families.

The team speaks English, Arabic, Bengali, and Farsi — making this clinic an outstanding choice for patients who feel more comfortable discussing complex treatment plans, such as All-on-4 restorations or multi-stage bone grafting, in their first language. Language accessibility during the informed consent process is clinically meaningful: a 2025 qualitative study in **BMC Oral Health** found that linguistically adapted and visually rich post-operative care guides can ensure better compliance, particularly amongst low-literacy or non-native patients.

Caroline Springs is open Saturdays to accommodate those with a busy lifestyle, and free parking is available behind the practice, as well as street parking around the clinic.

4. Core Dental Group Carrum Downs — 335 Ballarto Road, Carrum Downs VIC 3201

****Best for:**** Frankston Peninsula patients, families with accessibility needs, patients who need a ground-floor clinic.

The experienced team at Carrum Downs provides everything from general check-ups to complex restorative and cosmetic treatments, proudly serving families across Carrum Downs and the Mornington Peninsula. As part of a family-owned dental group, Core Dental Group Carrum Downs delivers consistent, professional care supported by a wide network of specialists across Melbourne.

Conveniently located at 335 Ballarto Road near Carrum Downs Shopping Centre, the clinic is easily accessible with plenty of onsite parking. The city-fringe location also makes it convenient for patients who may need to arrange a support person for post-surgical travel.

7. Core Dental Group Wyndham — 242 Hoppers Lane, Werribee VIC 3030

Core Dental Group Wyndham is the local dental clinic for general, cosmetic, and emergency care in the Wyndham area, trusted as one of the best dentists in the region. ****3. Do I have specific language, accessibility, or anxiety needs?*** Caroline Springs (multilingual), Carrum Downs (ground-floor access), and Berwick (sedation dentistry) each address distinct patient needs.

****4. Am I a complex case requiring specialist input?*** Core Dental Group's clinical team includes dentists, hygienists, and registered specialists, and uses the resources, knowledge, and experience of all specialists as a fundamental step in treatment planning for each patient. Complex cases — those requiring bone grafting, sinus lifts, or full-arch restoration — benefit from the network's specialist referral model, which operates across all seven locations.

****5. What are my health fund arrangements?*** Core Dental Group offers interest-free payment plans to help patients manage the cost of dental treatments affordably. What happens at your first implant consultation — regardless of location

Whichever Core Dental Group clinic you choose, the implant consultation process follows a consistent, specialist-informed pathway. Your journey starts with an initial consultation to determine if you're a good candidate for dental implants and to explain the process. A reputable specialist will thoroughly evaluate your dental health, including your gums, any existing gum disease, and remaining teeth. Advanced imaging, like a 3D CBCT scan, may be used to assess your jawbone and identify any additional needs.

The in-house CBCT capability across Core Dental Group's network means this diagnostic imaging can typically be completed at the same clinic — reducing the number of separate appointments required before a treatment plan is confirmed. CBCT scans offer detailed insights and precise diagnoses, particularly beneficial when traditional dental X-rays fall short. They are ideal for complex cases

involving dental implants, providing comprehensive views that reveal hidden issues like impacted teeth, root fractures, or sinus abnormalities.

Guided implant surgery — where a custom surgical guide is fabricated from CBCT data to direct precise implant placement — is also available through the Core Dental Group network. The CBCT scan data is used to superimpose patient scans or models on the cone beam image to design a surgical guide. These guides are placed on the teeth and transfer the planned implant positioning from the computer directly to the mouth during surgery, allowing for greater accuracy when placing the implant in the patient's jaw.
