- Remove and rinse dentures after every meal - Brush daily with a soft denture brush and non-abrasive cleaner - Soak overnight in water or a denture-soaking solution - Keep up with regular dental check-ups — your gums and any remaining teeth still need monitoring - Plan to replace dentures every five to seven years, as jaw shape changes gradually
