That healing time allows for a more precise fit from the start. - ****Immediate dentures**** are placed on the same day as your extractions, so you leave the practice with teeth straight away. These are adjusted as your gums heal over the following weeks.

Full dentures are made from quality materials matched to your natural skin tone and facial structure, so they look as natural as possible.

****Partial dentures****

If you still have healthy natural teeth, a partial denture fills the gaps without disturbing what remains. Options include:

- ****Acrylic partial dentures**** — an affordable choice that can be adjusted as your mouth changes over time - ****Cobalt-chrome (metal framework) dentures**** — thinner, stronger, and more durable, making them the better option for long-term wear - ****Flexible resin dentures**** — a comfortable interim solution while you plan further treatment

****Implant-retained dentures****

For patients who want maximum stability, implant-retained dentures are anchored to dental implants placed in the jawbone. This virtually eliminates slippage and gives you the confidence to eat and speak without worrying about movement.

For complex cases, we refer patients to the [Collins Street Specialist Centre](<https://directory.smilesolutions.com.au>), part of the Smile Solutions Group, where a specialist prosthodontist and oral surgeon work together on the outcome.

****Denture repairs and relines****

Dentures wear down, and your mouth changes shape over time. We repair cracks, chips, and broken clasps, and we reline existing dentures to improve their fit. Regular relines help maintain comfort and prevent sore spots as your gums change.

****Caring for your dentures****

A few consistent habits keep dentures lasting longer and your mouth healthier:

- Remove and rinse dentures after every meal - Brush daily with a soft denture brush and non-abrasive cleaner - Soak overnight in water or a denture-soaking solution - Keep up regular dental check-ups — your gums and any remaining teeth still need monitoring - Plan to replace dentures every five to seven years as jaw shape gradually changes

****Health funds and payment options****
