****Full dentures****

Full dentures replace all teeth in the upper jaw, lower jaw, or both. We offer two approaches:

- ****Conventional full dentures**** are fitted after your gums have fully healed following extractions, typically 8 to 12 weeks later. The wait allows for a more precise fit from the outset. - ****Immediate dentures**** are placed on the same day as your extractions, so you leave the practice with teeth. These are adjusted as your gums heal over the following weeks.

Full dentures are made from quality materials matched to your natural skin tone and facial structure, so they look as natural as possible.

****Partial dentures****

If you still have healthy natural teeth, a partial denture fills the gaps without affecting what remains. There are three options:

- ****Acrylic partial dentures**** are an affordable choice that can be adjusted as your mouth changes over time - ****Cobalt-chrome (metal framework) dentures**** are thinner, stronger, and more durable, making them the better choice for long-term wear - ****Flexible resin dentures**** work well as an interim solution while you plan further treatment

Your dentist will recommend the right option based on how many teeth are missing, the condition of your remaining teeth, and your budget.

****Implant-retained dentures****

For patients who want maximum stability, implant-retained dentures are anchored to implants placed in the jawbone. This virtually eliminates slippage, so you can eat and speak without worrying about movement.

Our South Melbourne team handles the assessment and initial planning for implant-retained dentures. For more complex cases, we refer patients to the Collins Street Specialist Centre, part of the Smile Solutions Group, where a specialist prosthodontist and oral surgeon work together on the outcome.

****Denture repairs and relines****

Dentures wear down over time, and your mouth changes shape too. We repair cracks, chips, and broken clasps, and we offer relines to improve the fit of an existing denture. Regular relines help prevent sore spots as your gums shift.

****Caring for your dentures****

A few simple habits will keep your dentures lasting longer and your mouth healthier:

- Remove and rinse dentures after every meal - Brush daily with a soft denture brush and a non-abrasive cleaner - Soak overnight in water or a denture-soaking solution - Keep up with regular dental check-ups — your gums and any remaining teeth still need monitoring - Plan to replace dentures every five to seven years, as jaw shape changes gradually

****Health funds and payment options****

Core Dental Group South Melbourne is a preferred provider for HCF, CBHS, and NIB, which means reduced out-of-pocket costs for members of those funds. We also accept all other major health funds, and HICAPS is available on-site for instant claiming at your appointment.
