Extractions are done under local anaesthesia with careful technique to keep discomfort to a minimum. For complex surgical extractions or impacted wisdom teeth, patients can be referred to the Collins Street Specialist Centre, where oral surgeons handle the more involved cases in a dedicated specialist setting.
