What is gum disease?

Gum disease — clinically known as periodontal disease — develops when plaque bacteria build up at and below the gumline. In its earliest form, gingivitis, you might notice bleeding gums when brushing, redness, or mild inflammation. Gingivitis is fully reversible with professional care and consistent oral hygiene at home. If it progresses into periodontitis, though, the infection starts breaking down the bone and connective tissue that keep your teeth in place, which can eventually cause tooth mobility and loss.

Many people don't realise they have gum disease because it can develop quietly over months or even years without causing pain. That's exactly why regular periodontal screening at Core Dental Group Carrum Downs matters — catching problems early makes treatment considerably more straightforward.

Comprehensive diagnosis and screening Every check-up at Core Dental Group Carrum Downs includes a thorough periodontal evaluation. Our dental professionals measure pocket depths around each tooth, check for recession, and review digital radiographs to assess bone support. Making periodontal screening a standard part of every examination means gum disease gets identified early, when treatment is simpler and more effective.

Deep cleaning — scaling and root planing Scaling and root planing is the primary non-surgical treatment for gum disease. This deep cleaning procedure removes calculus and bacterial deposits from beneath the gumline and along root surfaces. Smoothing the roots creates the right conditions for gum tissue to heal, reattach to the tooth, and reduce pocket depths over time. Depending on how far the disease has progressed, the procedure may take one or more visits, and local anaesthetic is used throughout to keep you comfortable.

Periodontal maintenance programmes Because periodontal disease is a chronic condition, ongoing management is essential. After initial treatment, we put together a personalised maintenance plan for each patient, with visits typically scheduled every three to four months. These appointments cover professional cleaning, pocket depth monitoring, and a careful review of gum and bone health. Keeping to a structured maintenance schedule is one of the most reliable ways to prevent the disease from returning and to protect your teeth over the long term.

Gum grafting referrals Where significant gum recession has left tooth roots exposed or affected structural integrity, gum grafting may be the recommended path forward. Core Dental Group Carrum Downs refers patients to specialist periodontists who perform soft tissue grafting to restore gum coverage, reduce root sensitivity, and bring the gumline back to a healthier position.

The Perio Squad — specialist gum disease management
