Screening and assessment

We use the Epworth Sleepiness Scale and STOP-Bang questionnaire to identify patients who may be at risk of obstructive sleep apnoea. Both are quick to complete and give us useful information to guide our recommendations.

CBCT airway analysis

Our Bayside practice has cone beam computed tomography (CBCT) technology, which produces detailed three-dimensional images of your upper airway. This lets us assess airway dimensions, identify areas of narrowing, and plan treatment with greater precision than standard two-dimensional imaging allows.

Referral to sleep physicians

Diagnosing obstructive sleep apnoea requires a formal sleep study arranged through a qualified sleep physician. When our screening suggests you may have OSA, we coordinate referrals to sleep physicians who can organise home-based or in-laboratory sleep studies. Once a diagnosis is confirmed, we work closely with your sleep physician to deliver the right treatment.

Mandibular advancement splints

For patients diagnosed with mild to moderate obstructive sleep apnoea, or those who can't tolerate CPAP therapy, a mandibular advancement splint (MAS) is an effective alternative. These custom-fitted oral devices are worn during sleep and work by gently positioning the lower jaw forward, which keeps the airway open and reduces both snoring and apnoeic events. Each splint is made from digital impressions taken at our practice, so the fit is comfortable and precise. We schedule follow-up appointments to adjust the device and confirm it's working as intended.

Complex cases and specialist referrals

Some patients have severe obstructive sleep apnoea or anatomical factors that need more advanced intervention. In those cases, we refer to the Collins Street Specialist Centre, where our oral and maxillofacial surgery team can assess whether surgical options are appropriate. This collaborative approach means every patient gets the level of care their condition actually requires.
