It's the go-to choice for patients with severe dental phobia or anyone facing complex, multi-step treatment. **Happy gas (nitrous oxide)** — Nitrous oxide is a mild sedative inhaled through a comfortable nasal mask. It produces a calm, pleasant sensation that takes the edge off anxiety without putting you under. The effects kick in quickly and clear within minutes of removing the mask, making it a practical option for patients who want gentle relaxation without deeper sedation.
