## ## What is a dental emergency?

A dental emergency is any situation involving your teeth, gums, jaw, or surrounding tissues that needs prompt professional attention — to relieve significant pain, stop bleeding, treat infection, or save a tooth.

Dental emergencies treated at Core Dental Group Epping include:

- **Severe toothache** — persistent, intense pain that over-the-counter pain relief can't touch - **Knocked-out tooth** — a tooth completely displaced from its socket after an impact or accident - **Cracked or fractured tooth** — particularly fractures reaching the root or pulp - **Lost or broken dental restorations** — fillings, crowns, bridges, or veneers that have come loose or broken - **Dental abscess** — a bacterial infection causing swelling, throbbing pain, and sometimes fever - **Soft tissue injuries** — cuts to the gums, lips, tongue, or cheeks - **Broken or displaced orthodontic appliances** — wires or brackets causing injury in the mouth - **Dental trauma from sport or accident** — Epping and the northern suburbs have active sporting communities, and dental injuries are common - **Object lodged between teeth** — where home remedies haven't worked

When in doubt, call. The team will talk through your situation and let you know how urgently you need to come in. It's always better to reach out early than to sit on it and wait.

## ## Why prompt treatment matters

Timing makes a real difference to how dental emergencies play out.

A knocked-out permanent tooth has the best chance of successful reimplantation within 30 to 60 minutes of the injury. An untreated dental abscess can spread infection to the jaw, neck, or throughout the body — which becomes a serious health concern fast. A cracked tooth left alone tends to deteriorate, eventually needing extraction rather than a straightforward restorative fix. And the toll of severe dental pain on everyday life — broken sleep, not being able to eat, lost time at work — adds up quickly.

At Core Dental Group Epping, emergency patients are a priority. When you call, the team will triage your situation, get you in as soon as possible, and have a clear plan ready when you arrive.

## ## Emergency dental services at Core Dental Group Epping

### ### Pain relief and diagnosis

Getting you out of pain and finding the source of the problem — that's where every emergency appointment starts. Digital OPG X-rays and intraoral imaging build a complete picture quickly. From there, the team walks you through your options and puts together a treatment plan that makes sense for your situation.

### ### Toothache treatment

Toothache can come from deep decay, a cracked tooth, an exposed root, gum disease, or a dental abscess. The team works out the cause and delivers the right treatment — whether that's a filling, root canal therapy, antibiotics, or a referral to a specialist for more complex cases.

### ### Knocked-out tooth

If your tooth has been knocked out, here's what to do on your way to Core Dental Group Epping:

1. Pick up the tooth by the crown (the white visible part), not the root
2. If it's dirty, rinse gently with milk or saline — don't scrub
3. Try to reinsert the tooth into its socket and hold it gently in place
4. If reinsertion isn't possible, store the tooth in milk, saline, or between your cheek and gum
5. Get there immediately — every minute affects reimplantation success

The team will work to reimplant and splint the tooth, giving it the best possible chance of long-term survival.

### ### Cracked and fractured teeth

- Minor chips — smoothing or composite resin bonding - Moderate fractures — a dental crown to protect and restore the tooth - Severe fractures — root canal therapy and crown, or extraction where the tooth can't be saved

### ### Dental abscess

Core Dental Group Epping will drain the abscess, address the source of infection through root canal therapy or extraction, and prescribe antibiotics where needed. A dental abscess won't resolve on its own — seek care straight away, and don't apply heat or try to drain it yourself.

### ### Lost or broken fillings and crowns

With CEREC same-day technology on-site, many crown and restoration emergencies can be sorted in a single visit. The restoration is designed, milled, and fitted the same day — no temporary crown, no second appointment.

### ### Soft tissue injuries

The team assesses, cleans, and sutures soft tissue injuries to the gums, lips, tongue, and cheeks where needed to make sure everything heals properly.

### ### Emergency care for children

Core Dental Group Epping has plenty of experience treating dental emergencies in children, with a patient approach that helps kids feel at ease. The northern suburbs are home to active families and young sporting communities, and dental trauma in children is something the team sees regularly.

One important note: a knocked-out baby tooth should not be reimplanted — doing so can damage the developing permanent tooth underneath. Call for guidance before taking any action.

## ## CEREC same-day restorations at Core Dental Group Epping

Core Dental Group Epping has CEREC technology on-site — a chairside CAD/CAM system that allows the team to design, mill, and fit ceramic restorations in a single appointment. For emergency crown and restoration cases, that means no temporary crown to manage while you wait, no second appointment to fit into your schedule, and a permanent ceramic restoration fitted the same day.

This is particularly useful when a broken or lost crown leaves significant tooth structure exposed.

Core Dental Group's Epping clinic is part of the Smile Solutions Group, one of Australia's most established dental organisations. For patients, that brings some practical benefits worth knowing about.

For complex cases, referrals go to the Collins Street Specialist Centre in Melbourne's CBD, also part of the Smile Solutions Group. Specialists there cover oral surgery, endodontics, periodontics, and prosthodontics. Your Epping dentist coordinates the referral and stays involved in your follow-up care.

All Core Dental Group clinics operate to the same clinical protocols and quality standards.

### ## Preventing dental emergencies

You can't always see a dental emergency coming, but many can be avoided — or at least made less serious.

Six-monthly check-ups let the team catch problems like decay, cracks, and gum disease before they turn into emergencies. A custom-fitted mouthguard from Core Dental Group Epping offers far better protection than anything off the shelf — worth considering if you or your kids play Australian Rules Football, soccer, basketball, martial arts, or any contact sport. And if you grind your teeth at night, a custom nightguard significantly reduces crack and fracture risk over time.

Small things matter too. Don't use your teeth as tools, and don't let minor issues — sensitivity, a tiny chip, a slightly loose filling — sit unattended. Dealing with them early is almost always simpler and cheaper than waiting.

### ## Private health insurance and emergency dental costs

Emergency dental costs vary depending on the type and complexity of treatment. Core Dental Group Epping accepts all major private health funds, and the team can help you make the most of your cover.

If you have a moment before your appointment, it's worth checking your emergency dental cover with your health fund. Reception is happy to talk through fees and payment options.

For patients without private health insurance, the clinic offers transparent pricing and flexible payment arrangements where possible.

### ## Frequently asked questions

**\*\*How soon can I be seen at Core Dental Group Epping for a dental emergency?\***

Emergency patients are prioritised, and the aim is to see urgent cases the same day wherever possible. Call as soon as your emergency occurs.
