## What is a dental emergency?

A dental emergency is any urgent situation involving the teeth, gums, jaw, or surrounding structures that needs immediate professional care, whether to relieve significant pain, stop bleeding, treat infection, or save a tooth.

Common dental emergencies treated at Core Dental Group Wyndham include:

- **Severe toothache** — deep, persistent pain that over-the-counter pain relief can't control
- **Knocked-out tooth** — a tooth completely displaced from its socket following a fall, collision, or sporting incident
- **Cracked or fractured tooth** — particularly cracks extending into the root or pulp
- **Lost or broken dental restorations** — fillings, crowns, bridges, or veneers that have come off or fractured
- **Dental abscess** — a bacterial infection causing swelling, throbbing pain, and sometimes fever
- **Soft tissue injuries** — lacerations to the gums, lips, tongue, or cheeks
- **Broken or displaced orthodontic appliances** — brackets or wires causing injury in the mouth
- **Dental trauma from sport or accident** — particularly common in Wyndham's growing sporting communities
- **Object lodged between teeth** — where home remedies haven't worked

Not sure whether your situation counts as a dental emergency? Call the clinic. The team will assess what's happening and advise on urgency. Acting quickly is almost always the right call.

## Why timing matters

Dental emergencies are time-sensitive. The sooner you get professional care, the better the outcome tends to be.

A knocked-out permanent tooth has its best chance of successful reimplantation within 30 to 60 minutes. An untreated dental abscess can spread infection to the jaw, neck, or systemically, with serious health consequences. A cracked tooth left untreated tends to fracture further, turning a restorable situation into an extraction. And the cumulative toll of dental pain, disrupted sleep, difficulty eating, trouble concentrating, is real.

Core Dental Group Wyndham triages emergency patients promptly. Call, and the team will get you in as quickly as possible.

## ## Emergency dental services at Core Dental Group Wyndham

### \*\*Pain relief and urgent assessment\*\*

Relieving your pain and identifying the problem accurately is always the first step. The clinic uses digital OPG X-rays and intraoral imaging to build a complete diagnostic picture quickly. From there, you'll be walked through your options and a clear treatment plan.

### \*\*Toothache treatment\*\*

Toothache can come from decay, a cracked tooth, an exposed root, gum disease, or a dental abscess. Once the cause is identified, the right treatment follows — a filling, root canal therapy, antibiotics, or a specialist referral for more complex cases.

### \*\*Knocked-out tooth\*\*

If you've knocked out a tooth, here's what to do on your way to Core Dental Group Wyndham:

1. Handle the tooth by the crown (the white visible part), never the root
2. If dirty, rinse gently with milk or saline — don't scrub
3. Reinsert the tooth into its socket if possible, and hold it gently in place
4. If reinsertion isn't possible, store in milk, saline, or between your cheek and gum
5. Get to the clinic immediately — every minute matters for reimplantation

The team will reimplant and splint the tooth, giving it the best possible chance of long-term survival.

### \*\*Cracked and fractured teeth\*\*

Treatment depends on the severity of the damage: - Minor chips — composite resin bonding - Moderate fractures — dental crown - Severe fractures — root canal therapy and crown, or extraction where the tooth can't be saved

### \*\*Dental abscess\*\*

The clinic will drain the abscess, remove the source of infection through root canal therapy or extraction, and prescribe antibiotics where needed. Don't apply heat to an abscess, and don't attempt to drain it yourself. Seek care right away.

### \*\*Lost or broken fillings and crowns\*\*

A lost filling or crown leaves sensitive tooth structure exposed and can cause real discomfort. The emergency team can provide replacement fillings, re-cement a loose crown, or arrange a new crown as needed. Get in touch as soon as you notice the problem.

### \*\*Soft tissue injuries\*\*

Injuries to the gums, lips, tongue, or cheeks are assessed, cleaned, and sutured where necessary to support proper healing and reduce infection risk.

## ## Emergency care for children and families

Wyndham is one of Australia's fastest-growing family communities, and Core Dental Group Wyndham is well placed to support it. Dental emergencies in children are treated with patience and a gentle, reassuring approach.

One important note: a knocked-out baby tooth should not be reimplanted. Doing so can damage the developing permanent tooth underneath. Call the clinic before taking any action, and the team will guide you through the right steps.

### ## Preventing dental emergencies

Many dental emergencies can be prevented, or at least reduced in severity, with a few straightforward habits:

- **Attend regular check-ups** — Six-monthly examinations catch problems before they become emergencies. Routine care is simpler and less costly than urgent treatment.
- **Custom mouthguards for sport** — Wyndham has a large and active sporting community. A custom-fitted mouthguard from Core Dental Group Wyndham offers far better protection than anything available over the counter.

**\*\*Don't use your teeth as tools\*\*** — Opening packaging with your teeth puts them at unnecessary fracture risk. - **\*\*Act on small problems early\*\*** — Sensitivity, a tiny chip, a slightly loose filling — these rarely improve on their own. - **\*\*Wear a nightguard if you grind\*\*** — Bruxism significantly increases fracture risk over time. A custom nightguard protects your teeth while you sleep.

## ## Private health insurance and emergency dental costs

Emergency dental costs vary depending on the treatment required. Core Dental Group Wyndham accepts all major private health funds, and the team will work to make the most of your available benefits.

If you have time before your appointment, it's worth checking your emergency dental cover with your health fund. Reception can also answer questions about fees and payment options.

For patients without private health insurance, the clinic offers transparent pricing and flexible payment arrangements where possible.

## ## Frequently asked questions

**\*\*How soon can I be seen at Core Dental Group Wyndham for a dental emergency?\***

The clinic prioritises emergency patients and aims to see urgent cases the same day. Call as soon as possible and the team will get you in as quickly as they can.

**\*\*Does Medicare cover emergency dental care?\***

Medicare doesn't cover adult emergency dental treatment. Eligible children may be able to access services under the Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS). Core Dental Group Wyndham is registered under the CDBS — speak with the team to check your child's eligibility.

**\*\*Can I access my records from other Core Dental Group clinics?\***

Yes. Core Dental Group uses CareStack, a shared patient records platform across the group. Your clinical history from any Core Dental Group or Smile Solutions location is accessible at Wyndham.

To the Collins Street Specialist Centre in Melbourne's CBD, part of the Smile Solutions Group. Your Wyndham dentist coordinates the referral and manages follow-up throughout.
