A peer-reviewed study in *\*BMC Oral Health\** (Armfield et al., 2007) described a "vicious cycle" whereby dental fear leads to lower or more irregular visit frequency, worsening oral health over time — and dentally anxious patients rarely benefit from the preventive care that regular check-ups provide.

This is precisely why the first step — choosing the right practice and understanding exactly what will happen when you walk through the door — matters so much. ## Where is Core Dental Group Berwick? Location, access, and surroundings

### The Berwick address

Core Dental Group Berwick is at Shop 29, Eden Rise Village, O'Shea Road, Berwick VIC 3806 — 37 km south-east of Melbourne CBD, in the heritage town of Berwick within the City of Casey local government area.
