Core Dental Group Carrum Downs is not a standalone practice. It's part of a family-owned dental group that has been owned and operated by a dentist since 1993. Together with Smile Solutions, the group has built a patient base of over 300,000, with around 20,000 new patients each year.

That scale matters for patients at the Carrum Downs location specifically. Being part of a larger group means the clinic can sustain access to registered specialist practitioners — including endodontists, periodontists, prosthodontists, orthodontists, paediatric dentists, and oral and maxillofacial surgeons — that most small independent practices simply can't support.

Physical location and access

The clinic is at Suite 5, 335 Ballarto Road, Carrum Downs VIC 3201, near Carrum Downs Shopping Centre, with onsite parking. The main phone number is (03) 8373-1555.

Carrum Downs sits within Frankston City council and the federal electorate of Isaacs, which positions the clinic as a natural primary dental provider for residents across Carrum Downs, Langwarrin, Seaford, Skye, Patterson Lakes, and the broader Frankston City area.

For patients with mobility needs, the clinic is on the ground floor with wide corridors and accessible treatment rooms.

Operating hours

The team — dentists, specialists, and hygienists — is available six days a week, with extended trading hours that include early morning starts from 8am on weekdays. That makes it practical for working adults and school-aged children to get to appointments without disrupting their week.

Multilingual staff

The Carrum Downs community is linguistically diverse, and the clinic's team reflects that. Ms Sandy Kaur speaks Hindi and Punjabi as well as English, which provides genuine language access for patients from South Asian backgrounds.

A practitioner profile: Dr Jacques Theron

Dr Jacques Theron graduated from the University of Pretoria with a Bachelor of Dental Surgery in 1998 and has since completed additional training in Invisalign (2013), SomnoMed Sleep Dentistry, and Dental Implant Surgery Fundamentals and Advanced Implant Site Management (2014). His focus is cosmetic dentistry — including Invisalign, crowns, and bridges — with a commitment to treatments that are non-invasive and as comfortable as possible.

Invisalign Blue Diamond status: what it means

Core Dental Group holds Blue Diamond provider status with Invisalign — the highest tier in the provider classification system, reserved for practices that have completed the greatest volume of cases. The orthodontic department sees more than 3,000 new patients a year, with over one-third of those being new Invisalign starts, making Core Dental Group one of the only Blue Diamond Invisalign providers in Australia.

For patients in the Frankston area researching clear aligner treatment, that credential is a meaningful indicator of clinical depth (see our guide on *Invisalign and Orthodontics in Carrum Downs: Braces vs Clear Aligners for Teens and Adults*).

Children's dental services and CDBS

The paediatric dentists at Carrum Downs treat children's dental problems in close collaboration with general dentists and dental therapists, covering fissure sealants, preventive care, decay treatment, and

dental emergencies including broken or lost teeth and trauma.

Eligible children can access bulk-billed services under the Medicare Child Dental Benefit Schedule (CDBS). Emergency dental care

The clinic's extended trading hours make routine care easy to access, and the same applies to urgent situations. Core Dental Group Carrum Downs accommodates emergency appointments for severe toothache, cracked or knocked-out teeth, and dental abscesses. Pricing, transparency, and payment options

Cost uncertainty is one of the most common barriers to dental care in Australia. In 2022–23, around \$12.5 billion was spent on dental services nationally, with patients paying \$7.6 billion of that — 61% — directly out of pocket. The average individual spent \$291 on dental services over the 12-month period, not including private health insurance premiums ([AIHW, 2024](<https://www.aihw.gov.au/reports/dental-oral-health/oral-health-and-dental-care-in-australia/contents/costs>)).

Core Dental Group addresses this directly. Written quotes are provided before treatment begins, so there are no surprises. Interest-free payment plans are available for all general, cosmetic, and specialist dental treatment, allowing patients to spread costs over time.

The clinic is also a preferred provider for three health insurance funds, which can reduce out-of-pocket costs for patients with private extras cover. This structured mentorship model has a direct benefit for patients: newer graduates at the practice work within a supervised, quality-assured environment rather than independently. It also helps the clinic maintain a large, diverse team across multiple disciplines.

What new patients can expect on their first visit

If you're attending Core Dental Group Carrum Downs for the first time, here's what a standard new patient visit typically looks like:

1. ****Arrival and check-in**** — The clinic is near Carrum Downs Shopping Centre with onsite parking. Ground-floor access and accessible facilities are available.
2. ****Medical and dental history review**** — Your dentist will go through your health history, current medications, and any concerns you've brought to the appointment.
3. ****Comprehensive examination**** — This includes a visual assessment of teeth and gums, periodontal probing where indicated, and digital X-rays to identify issues not visible to the naked eye.
4. ****Treatment planning discussion**** — Any recommended treatments are discussed with you, with a written quote provided before you commit to anything.
5. ****Preventive clean**** — If no urgent

treatment is required, a professional scale and clean is typically done at the same appointment or scheduled promptly. 6. **Recall scheduling** — You'll be advised on your recommended recall interval (typically six months for most adults) and enrolled in a reminder system.
