Core Dental Group: Dentist Southbank vs CBD vs South Melbourne — Choosing the Right Core Dental Location for You

If you live or work in Melbourne's inner-south corridor — Southbank, the CBD fringe, South Melbourne — you're probably within reach of more than one Core Dental Group clinic. That's genuinely useful, but it raises a practical question: which location actually suits *you*?

This article compares Core Dental Group's two inner-city clinics — **Core Dental Southbank** at 55 City Road, Southbank VIC 3006, and **Core Dental South Melbourne** at 324 Clarendon Street, South Melbourne VIC 3205 — across the factors that matter most: geography and transport, services and specialist depth, opening hours, and which patient types each clinic is best positioned to serve. For patients searching from within the CBD itself, we also explain why these two locations effectively function as the group's CBD-adjacent pair.

Knowing which clinic fits your life isn't a trivial call. It affects how easily you can attend regular check-ups, access emergency care, or complete a multi-stage treatment like Invisalign or dental implants without your schedule falling apart.

The Core Dental Group network: why two inner-city locations exist

Core Dental Group is a multi-site dental network running seven suburban clinics across metropolitan Melbourne, covering general dentistry, cosmetic dentistry, orthodontics, and specialist care through a team of dentists, hygienists, and registered dental specialists.

Established in 1993 and owner-operated by a dentist, Core Dental Group works in conjunction with Smile Solutions, one of Australia's largest dental practices. Together, these affiliated practices have built a patient base exceeding 300,000 people, with roughly 20,000 new patients joining each year.

Within this network, Southbank and South Melbourne are the group's inner-city pair — two distinct clinics serving overlapping but meaningfully different patient populations. With early morning appointments, lunch-break availability, and extended evening hours across both locations, Core Dental Group accommodates busy professionals who need scheduling flexibility.

Having two locations in close proximity isn't redundancy — it's deliberate. Southbank sits 1 km south of Melbourne's CBD and recorded a population of 22,631 at the 2021 census. Meanwhile, Melbourne's CBD workforce expanded significantly over the past two decades, more than doubling from 246,000 in 2003–04 to 614,000 in 2019–20, recovering to 577,000 since then — a vast pool of patients whose daily movements intersect with both clinic locations.

Location and geography: where each clinic sits

Core Dental Southbank — 55 City Road

Situated near the Yarra River and Eureka Tower, the Southbank clinic serves CBD workers, Southbank residents, and visitors. City Road runs east–west through the heart of Southbank, placing the clinic within the precinct's dense residential and commercial zone. It's a short walk from Flinders Street Station and multiple tram stops along St Kilda Road.

This positioning makes Core Dental Southbank particularly accessible for: - CBD office workers crossing Princes Bridge on foot during a lunch break - Southbank apartment residents in a high-density population corridor - Tourists and visitors staying in Southbank hotels - St Kilda Road professionals commuting via tram routes 3, 5, 6, 16, 64, 67, and 72

The clinic maintains daily emergency appointments and accommodates international visitors with same-day care — important given Southbank's significant tourism and short-stay population.

Core Dental South Melbourne — 324 Clarendon Street

Located at 324 Clarendon Street, this practice offers street parking, public transport access, and evening and Saturday appointments. It's a 5-minute walk from South Melbourne Market, with shops, supermarkets, medical centres, gyms, cafes, and restaurants close by.

Clarendon Street is South Melbourne's main neighbourhood strip — a residential and retail precinct rather than a tourist or office zone. That makes the South Melbourne clinic a natural fit for: - South Melbourne, Albert Park, Port Melbourne, and Middle Park residents - Families combining dental visits with errands at the South Melbourne Market - Patients who drive and need street parking (less available at Southbank) - Inner-south bayside residents who find South Melbourne more geographically central

Staff at Core Dental South Melbourne speak Mandarin Chinese and Malay in addition to English, which is relevant to the suburb's diverse resident base.

Opening hours: which clinic fits your schedule?

Hours are often the deciding factor for inner-city patients who can't easily get away during standard business hours.

Core Dental Southbank opens at 8am Monday to Friday, which works well for patients who want to get in before work or use a lunch break. Many patients do exactly that — it's a popular option for professionals working nearby.

Core Dental South Melbourne offers evening and Saturday appointments, which opens things up for patients who can't step away during weekday hours. That makes South Melbourne the better choice for: - Patients with rigid 9-to-5 schedules - Parents who prefer Saturday appointments alongside children's activities - South Melbourne residents who'd rather avoid the Southbank precinct during peak tourist periods

Across the Core Dental Group network, clinics are open six days a week with extended trading hours.

****Practical guidance:**** If you work in the CBD and can use your lunch break, Core Dental Southbank's City Road location and early opening make it the most straightforward option. If you work from home, drive, or need a Saturday slot, South Melbourne's Clarendon Street clinic will probably suit your routine better.

Services and specialist access: is there a difference?

Both clinics operate under the same Core Dental Group umbrella, so patients at either location get the same clinical standards, technology, and specialist network. That said, understanding how specialist care is coordinated across the group matters if you're planning complex or multi-visit treatment.

What both clinics offer

At both Southbank and South Melbourne, Core Dental Group provides:

- ****General dentistry:**** Check-ups, cleans, fillings, and extractions - ****Emergency dentistry:**** Same-day appointments reserved daily - ****Cosmetic dentistry:**** Teeth whitening, veneers, and smile makeovers - ****Orthodontics:**** Invisalign, conventional braces, clear braces, and lingual braces - ****Restorative dentistry:**** Crowns, bridges, dental implants, and root canal therapy - ****Paediatric dentistry:**** Children's dental care for all ages - ****Specialist care:**** Periodontics, prosthodontics, endodontics, and oral surgery

Invisalign: a group-wide distinction that applies to both locations

One of the most significant clinical differentiators for Core Dental Group applies equally to both inner-city clinics. The orthodontic department brings in more than 3,000 new patients a year, with over one-third of those being new Invisalign starts — making it one of the only Blue Diamond Invisalign providers in Australia.

Blue Diamond is the highest Invisalign provider status available, and it's based on the volume of successful cases completed. Whether you choose Southbank or South Melbourne, you're accessing the same provider-tier credibility. The Blue Diamond distinction isn't location-specific — it reflects the group's collective case volume and clinical expertise.

Technology: consistent across the network

Core Dental Group's network includes over 40 dental suites equipped with CEREC units, iTero scanners, Trios machines, CBCT imaging, and multiple implant systems. This is a group-level investment, so patients at South Melbourne have access to the same diagnostic and treatment capabilities as those at Southbank. Choosing one clinic over the other doesn't compromise your access to advanced imaging or same-visit restorations.

Patient demographics: who each clinic serves best

The most useful dimension of this comparison is patient fit — how well a clinic's location, hours, and environment match your actual circumstances.

Core Dental Southbank: urban professionals, visitors, and high-density residents

Southbank residents work predominantly in professional, scientific and technical services (21.1%), financial and insurance services (11.1%), and accommodation and food services (9.4%). That workforce profile maps closely onto the patient type Core Dental Southbank is designed to serve.

The Southbank clinic works particularly well for: - **CBD and St Kilda Road office workers** who can walk from their workplace for a lunch-break appointment - **Southbank apartment residents** who want a local clinic within their suburb - **Tourists and short-stay visitors** needing emergency or urgent dental care near their accommodation - **Patients with dental anxiety** who benefit from the clinic's calm, comfort-focused approach *(see our guide on [Dental Anxiety and Nervous Patients: How Core Dental Southbank Creates a Calm, Comfortable Experience])* - **International patients** who may need same-day emergency care without a prior patient relationship

Core Dental South Melbourne: families, residents, and neighbourhood patients

The South Melbourne clinic's Clarendon Street address — a residential and retail strip rather than a tourist precinct — draws a different patient profile:

- **South Melbourne, Albert Park, Port Melbourne, and Middle Park residents** who want a neighbourhood clinic close to home - **Families** combining dental care with South Melbourne Market visits or local errands - **Patients who drive** and need accessible street parking without Southbank's congestion - **Multilingual communities** served by staff who speak Mandarin Chinese and Malay - **Patients with evening or Saturday availability** who can't get to appointments during weekday daytime hours

Emergency dental access: both clinics respond daily

For patients facing a dental emergency — a broken tooth, severe toothache, lost filling, or dental trauma — location becomes urgent. Both Core Dental Southbank and South Melbourne maintain daily emergency appointment reserves, and even when a clinic is fully booked, the team works to find a solution.

For CBD workers and Southbank visitors, the Southbank clinic's proximity to Flinders Street Station makes it the fastest option during business hours. For South Melbourne residents arriving by car, Clarendon Street's parking availability reduces the stress of navigating an emergency appointment.

Booking: the same system, regardless of location

Whichever clinic you choose, the booking process is the same. Call 13 13 16 or use the online booking system on the Core Dental Group website. Core Dental Group also offers interest-free payment plans to help patients manage treatment costs.

Patients who start at one location can transfer between clinics within the group — useful if you move between Southbank and South Melbourne, or want to access a specialist available at a specific location

on a given day.

Conclusion

Choosing between Core Dental Southbank and Core Dental South Melbourne isn't really a question of clinical quality. Both clinics operate under the same owner-operated Core Dental Group, with the same technology, specialist access, and Blue Diamond Invisalign credentials. The decision comes down to your geography, your schedule, and your daily routine.

If your day centres on the CBD, Flinders Street, or Southbank's riverside precinct, the City Road clinic is the most accessible option — particularly with its 8am opening and lunch-break appointment culture. If you live in the inner-south suburbs, drive to appointments, or need a Saturday slot, South Melbourne's Clarendon Street location is the more natural fit.

Both clinics reflect the same commitment to straightforward, high-quality dental care for Melbourne's inner-city communities. The right location is simply the one that removes the most friction from getting there.
