Why location matters for dental care in Melbourne's west

Research published in the *Australian Dental Journal* (Mejia et al., 2014) consistently shows that geographic access — particularly travel time — is one of the primary factors determining whether Australians seek regular preventive dental care. In outer-suburban and growth-corridor communities, where car dependency is high and specialist services are sparse, the catchment area of a well-equipped dental clinic becomes a genuine health equity issue.

Melbourne's western corridor, encompassing over 60 suburbs, had an estimated 980,300 residents as of 2024–2025 — a 33% increase from 735,070 a decade prior, according to Australian Bureau of Statistics data. Within this broader corridor, the City of Melton's population is projected to grow from 232,721 residents in 2024 to 470,596 by 2046, ultimately surpassing the current population of Canberra.

The City of Melton is one of the fastest-growing municipalities in Australia, and it takes in a series of townships and communities including Caroline Springs, located 19 kilometres west of Melbourne's CBD.

Against this backdrop of rapid growth, the supply of specialist dental services in the west has not kept pace with demand. Core Dental Group's Caroline Springs clinic is a modern, full-service dental practice located in the CS Square shopping precinct, offering comprehensive dental care to the local community and Melbourne's western growth corridor. Its central position within the suburb cluster makes it the most accessible specialist dental provider for a wide ring of surrounding communities.

Where is Core Dental Caroline Springs located?

Core Dental Caroline Springs is at 224–226 Caroline Springs Boulevard, Caroline Springs VIC 3023, directly adjacent to CS Square — the suburb's main commercial and retail hub — making it one of the most accessible professional health services in the area. Caroline Springs is 21 km west of Melbourne's CBD. The suburb's main arterial, Caroline Springs Boulevard, feeds into both the Deer Park Bypass and the Western Highway to the south, and connects to Melbourne via either the Western Ring Road or the Princes Highway.

This road network explains why Core Dental Group's catchment extends well beyond Caroline Springs itself: multiple arterial roads converge near CS Square, drawing patients from a broad ring of neighbouring suburbs.

Suburbs served by Core Dental Caroline Springs

Twelve suburbs have their centres within 6 km of Caroline Springs: Burnside Heights, Albanvale, Taylors Hill, Delahey, Kings Park, Cairnlea, Deer Park, Saint Albans, Sydenham, Derrimut, Ardeer, and Rockbank.

Below is a suburb-by-suburb breakdown of the Core Dental Caroline Springs catchment, with estimated driving times based on standard road conditions.

Taylors Hill — 3 to 6 minutes by car

Taylors Hill, with its modern homes and family-friendly parks, sits to the north of Caroline Springs. It's one of the most natural feeder suburbs for Core Dental Group, with residents able to reach CS Square via Taylors Road or the Caroline Springs Boulevard extension in under 6 minutes under typical conditions.

For families in Taylors Hill seeking paediatric dental care or orthodontic consultations, Core Dental Group's specialist team is effectively a neighbourhood-level resource (see our guide on **Children's Dentist in Caroline Springs: Paediatric Dental Care at Core Dental**).

Burnside and Burnside Heights — 3 to 7 minutes by car

The Caroline Springs postcode (3023) is shared with Burnside, Burnside Heights, Ravenhall, and Cairnlea, which means many residents in these suburbs already treat the Caroline Springs commercial precinct as their local shopping and services hub.

Burnside Heights sits just 500 metres from the Caroline Springs town square — close enough that a trip to Core Dental Group can be combined with shopping at CS Square, reducing the time cost of attending regular check-ups.

Burnside residents are well positioned to reach Core Dental Caroline Springs via the Kororoit Creek Road corridor in under 7 minutes.

Deer Park — 7 to 12 minutes by car

Deer Park, with its diverse community and convenient shopping options, is to the southeast of Caroline Springs. Access is straightforward via the Western Ring Road or directly along the Deer Park Bypass, with most residential pockets reachable in 8–12 minutes.

Deer Park has a long-established, multicultural population — a demographic profile that aligns closely with Core Dental Group's multilingual team, which speaks English, Arabic, Bengali, and Farsi. For Deer Park patients seeking cosmetic dental treatments, implants, or specialist orthodontic care not available at a standard local practice, Core Dental Group is the nearest full-service specialist option (see our guide on **Dental Implants in Caroline Springs: Replacing Missing Teeth with Core Dental**).

Kings Park — 7 to 10 minutes by car

Kings Park is a quiet, predominantly residential suburb to the east of Caroline Springs, accessible via the Ballarat Road or Sunshine Avenue corridors. Driving time from most Kings Park addresses to CS Square is typically 7–10 minutes.

For Kings Park patients, Core Dental Group offers a meaningful step up in service availability compared to smaller general practices in the immediate area — particularly for families needing both general and specialist care in one place (see our guide on **What to Expect at Core Dental Caroline Springs: Clinic Overview, Team & Services**).

Albanvale — 8 to 12 minutes by car

Albanvale is among the recognised nearby neighbourhoods of Caroline Springs. Located to the southeast, it's accessible via Ballarat Road and the Kings Road connector, with most residential addresses falling within a 10–12 minute drive of Core Dental Group's CS Square location.

Albanvale has a significant proportion of residents from culturally and linguistically diverse (CALD) backgrounds. With 45% of City of Melton residents speaking languages other than English at home (Census 2021), Core Dental Group's multilingual capability — spanning English, Arabic, Bengali, and Farsi — is a practical accessibility advantage for Albanvale patients (see our guide on **Oral Health for Melbourne's Multicultural Western Communities: Core Dental's Culturally Inclusive Approach**).

Sunshine and Sunshine West — 12 to 18 minutes by car

While Sunshine sits within the City of Brimbank rather than Melton, its western residential pockets — particularly Sunshine West and Sunshine North — fall within a practical driving catchment of Core Dental Caroline Springs. Travel via the Western Ring Road or Ballarat Road typically places these suburbs 12–18 minutes from CS Square.

For Sunshine residents needing specialist services such as orthodontics, oral surgery, or endodontic treatment, Core Dental Group's registered specialist team offers a level of care that's otherwise hard to access locally without travelling into Melbourne's inner west or CBD. This is particularly relevant for patients researching Invisalign or braces, given Core Dental Group's Blue Diamond Provider status (see our guide on **Orthodontist in Caroline Springs: Invisalign, Braces & Teeth Straightening at Core Dental**).

Keilor Downs, Sydenham, and Delahey — 10 to 15 minutes by car

The northern arc of Core Dental Group's catchment includes Keilor Downs, Sydenham, and Delahey — suburbs along the Sunbury Line train corridor, well connected to Caroline Springs via the Calder Freeway and Taylors Road.

The railway stations closest to Burnside Heights — and by extension this northern arc of suburbs — are Keilor Plains and Watergardens, both on the Sunbury line, at 4 minutes and 8 minutes driving distance respectively. For patients from these suburbs without a car, the public transport connection to Caroline Springs is a real option.

Getting to Core Dental Caroline Springs: public transport access

Melbourne's western suburbs are predominantly car-dependent — Caroline Springs has a Walk Score of 43 — but public transport connections have improved considerably in recent years.

Train access

Caroline Springs railway station opened in January 2017. Located on Christies Road, Ravenhall VIC 3023, it's operated by V/Line on the Ballarat and Ararat lines, with 750 parking spaces on-site.

Bus routes 215, 460, and 462 connect to Caroline Springs Railway Station, alongside V/Line Ballarat and Geelong train services. From the station, the CS Square precinct is accessible by a short bus or taxi trip.

Bus access

Bus lines 215, 418, 426, and 460 stop near Caroline Springs. The most relevant route for dental patients is Route 460, the main north-south route through Caroline Springs, running from Watergardens Station to Caroline Springs Station across 35 stops, with a full trip taking approximately 27 minutes.

Route 462 connects passengers to Metro trains at Watergardens Station and V/Line trains at Caroline Springs Station, running every 20 minutes during peak hours and every 40 minutes off-peak.

For patients from Taylors Hill, Burnside Heights, and Keilor Downs, buses along this corridor provide a workable car-free option for routine appointments.

Parking at Core Dental Caroline Springs

For patients travelling by car, parking is one of the most practical considerations when choosing a dental clinic. Core Dental Group's location at 224–226 Caroline Springs Boulevard, adjacent to CS Square, benefits from the precinct's substantial retail car park, which provides free, accessible parking directly outside the clinic entrance.

Patients with mobility considerations or prams will find ground-level accessible parking bays close to the clinic entrance — an important factor for families attending with young children or elderly relatives (see our guide on *Children's Dentist in Caroline Springs: Paediatric Dental Care at Core Dental*).

This single-location model is particularly valuable for patients from outer suburbs who want to avoid multiple referrals across different providers. A family in Taylors Hill, for example, can bring their child to a specialist paediatric dentist, complete their own general check-up, and consult an orthodontist about Invisalign — all in one visit, at one address.
