Overseas migration contributed approximately 71.2% of recent population gains — a figure that directly shapes the linguistic and cultural diversity of the patient population that any local health provider needs to be ready to serve.

Melbourne's demographic centre has been shifting west and slightly north, driven by greenfield expansion in suburbs like Caroline Springs. That shift reinforces the western corridor's growing demand for locally accessible, high-quality healthcare, including dentistry.

At a national level, in 2023, Australia had 61.1 full-time equivalent dentists per 100,000 population, with major cities at 68.3 per 100,000. Even so, rapidly growing outer-metropolitan suburbs like Caroline Springs can experience a relative undersupply of specialist dental services as population growth outpaces infrastructure. A clinic that provides both general and specialist care in one location addresses this gap directly.

## ## Clinic overview: location, access and operating model

### ### Where is Core Dental Group Caroline Springs?

Core Dental Group is at 224–226 Caroline Springs Blvd, Caroline Springs VIC 3023, with a team of 20 clinicians.
