What Is Invisalign?

Invisalign is an orthodontic treatment system that uses a series of custom-made, clear plastic aligners to move teeth into their desired positions. Each set of aligners is worn for approximately one to two weeks before being replaced with the next set in the series, with each new aligner making small, precise adjustments to tooth position.

What Invisalign Can Treat

- **Crowded teeth** — when there isn't enough room in the jaw for all teeth to sit naturally - **Gaps between teeth** — spacing issues that affect appearance and can trap food - **Overbite** — when upper front teeth overlap significantly over lower front teeth - **Underbite** — when lower teeth sit in front of upper teeth - **Crossbite** — when some upper teeth sit inside the lower teeth when the jaw is closed - **Open bite** — when upper and lower teeth don't meet when the jaw is closed - **General misalignment** — teeth that are rotated, tilted, or otherwise out of position

While Invisalign handles the vast majority of orthodontic cases, some complex situations may still require traditional braces or a combination approach. During your initial consultation, we'll assess your specific case and recommend the most effective treatment for your needs.

"Will it actually work for my case?"

Invisalign has advanced enormously since its early days when it could only treat simple crowding. Modern Invisalign can treat mild, moderate, and many complex orthodontic cases — including significant crowding, spacing, overbites, underbites, crossbites, and open bites. However, it's not the right solution for every case. Some highly complex malocclusions may still require traditional braces, surgical intervention, or a combination approach.

During your consultation, we'll assess your specific case honestly. If Invisalign can deliver an excellent result, we'll tell you. If it can't, or if another approach would be more effective, we'll tell you that too. Our Blue Diamond experience means we've seen enough cases to know the difference — and we'd rather direct you to the right treatment than force Invisalign onto a case where it won't perform at its best.

"I've heard compliance is a problem"

Invisalign requires you to wear your aligners for 20–22 hours per day to be effective. If you only wear them when you feel like it, treatment will take longer and results will be compromised. This self-discipline element is a genuine consideration — particularly for teenagers.

That said, most patients find that wearing aligners becomes second nature within a few days. They're comfortable, virtually invisible, and the routine of removing them for meals and reinserting them after brushing becomes automatic very quickly. The key is commitment in the first few days while the habit forms.

For teens, Invisalign includes compliance indicators — small blue dots on the aligners that fade with wear, giving parents and clinicians a visual check that aligners are being worn as directed.

"Will people notice I'm wearing them?"

Invisalign aligners are made from a clear, transparent thermoplastic material. When worn, they're extremely difficult to detect — most people won't notice them unless they're specifically looking for them. Step 1: Initial Consultation

Your Invisalign journey begins with a comprehensive consultation at our Carrum Downs practice. During this appointment, we'll:

- Discuss your goals — what you'd like to change about your smile
- Conduct a thorough examination of your teeth, gums, and bite
- Take digital photographs
- Perform a ****complimentary 3D scan**** of your teeth using our iTero digital scanner — no messy, gag-inducing impressions

The digital scan creates a precise 3D model of your teeth that's used for treatment planning. It's fast, comfortable, and far more accurate than traditional impressions.

Step 2: Custom Treatment Plan with ClinCheck

Using the 3D scan data, we create your personalised treatment plan using Invisalign's ClinCheck software. This is where things get exciting — ClinCheck generates a virtual representation of your treatment from start to finish, showing you exactly how your teeth will move at each stage.

****You get to see your projected results before committing to treatment.**** This is one of Invisalign's most powerful features. You can visualise the planned movement of every tooth and see a simulation of your final smile. It helps you make an informed decision and sets clear expectations for the outcome.

- The estimated number of aligners you'll need
- The projected treatment duration
- Any attachments (small tooth-coloured dots bonded to certain teeth to help the aligners grip) that may be needed

Step 3: Receiving Your Aligners

Once you approve your treatment plan, your custom aligners are manufactured by Invisalign using advanced 3D printing and trimming technology. Each aligner is made to precise specifications based on your ClinCheck plan.

When your aligners arrive at our practice, we'll fit your first set, place any necessary attachments, and make sure everything feels comfortable. We'll also give you detailed instructions on:

- How long to wear

your aligners each day (typically 20–22 hours) - How and when to change to the next set - How to care for your aligners - What to expect in the first few days (mild pressure is normal as your teeth begin to move)

Step 4: Wearing Your Aligners

This is the part where the work happens — though "work" is perhaps too strong a word. You simply wear your aligners throughout the day and night, removing them only for eating, drinking anything other than water, and brushing your teeth.

****Daily routine with Invisalign:**** - Wear aligners for 20–22 hours per day - Remove for meals and snacks — eat whatever you like - Brush teeth before reinserting aligners - Clean aligners gently with a soft toothbrush and lukewarm water - Change to the next set of aligners as directed (typically every one to two weeks)

Most patients adapt to wearing Invisalign within a day or two. Speech may be slightly affected initially, but this resolves quickly as your tongue adjusts to the aligners.

Step 5: Progress Check-ups

Throughout your treatment, you'll visit our Carrum Downs practice for periodic check-ups — typically every six to eight weeks. These appointments are usually quick and straightforward. We'll assess your progress, ensure your teeth are tracking according to plan, and provide your next sets of aligners.

Step 6: Refinement (If Needed)

In some cases, additional aligners (called refinement aligners) may be needed at the end of the initial series to achieve the final result. This is a normal part of the Invisalign process and is included in most treatment plans. Refinement aligners address any teeth that may not have moved quite as far as planned and help fine-tune your final smile.

Step 7: Retainers

Once your teeth are in their final positions, retainers are essential to keep them there. Without retention, teeth have a natural tendency to drift back toward their original positions over time.

We'll provide you with retainers and advise on a wearing schedule. Most patients wear retainers full-time initially, transitioning to nighttime-only wear after a period. Retainers are a lifelong commitment to maintaining your results — but they're simple, comfortable, and become second nature very quickly.

Invisalign and Your Oral Health

One of the underappreciated benefits of straighter teeth is the impact on your overall oral health. Crooked, crowded, or misaligned teeth create areas that are difficult to clean — tight overlapping surfaces where floss can't reach, and irregular contours where plaque accumulates. Over time, these hard-to-clean areas become hotspots for decay and gum disease.

By straightening your teeth, Invisalign doesn't just improve your smile — it makes your teeth easier to maintain. Properly aligned teeth are simpler to brush effectively, easier to floss, and less likely to develop the plaque traps that lead to cavities and periodontal problems.

For patients who have struggled with recurring cavities or gum issues despite good oral hygiene, misalignment may be a contributing factor worth addressing.

Bite Correction and Joint Health

Misaligned bites (malocclusions) can contribute to uneven wear on teeth, jaw joint problems (TMJ/TMD), headaches, and muscle tension. By correcting the bite relationship, Invisalign can alleviate these symptoms and distribute biting forces more evenly across all teeth — extending the lifespan of your natural teeth and any existing dental work.

Invisalign for Teens

Invisalign isn't just for adults. Invisalign Teen (now integrated into the main Invisalign system) is specifically designed for teenage patients, with features that address the unique challenges of treating adolescents:

- **Compliance indicators** — small blue dots on the aligners that fade with wear, giving parents and clinicians a visual check that the aligners are being worn as directed - **Eruption compensation** — built-in features that accommodate teeth that are still erupting - **Replacement aligners** — because teenagers occasionally lose things, replacement aligners are included in the treatment plan

For families in Carrum Downs with teenagers who are self-conscious about their smile, Invisalign offers a discreet alternative that doesn't affect their confidence during what can be a sensitive time. They can play sport, attend social events, and go about their school day without the visible hardware of traditional braces.

Invisalign for Adults

There's no upper age limit for Invisalign. We regularly treat adults in their 30s, 40s, 50s, and beyond who want to improve their smile. Some had braces as teenagers but experienced relapse over the years. Others never had orthodontic treatment and have always been self-conscious about crooked or crowded teeth.

Common reasons adults choose Invisalign: - Teeth that have shifted over the years - Crowding that makes cleaning difficult (increasing the risk of decay and gum disease) - A desire to improve their smile for personal or professional reasons - Preparation for other dental work (sometimes teeth need to be moved into better positions before placing veneers, implants, or bridges)

As an adult, the discretion of Invisalign is particularly appealing. You can go through treatment without most people even noticing — no "metal mouth" comments, no professional awkwardness, no self-consciousness in photos.

Frequently Asked Questions About Invisalign

Does Invisalign hurt?

Most patients experience mild pressure or tightness when they switch to a new set of aligners, particularly in the first day or two. This is a sign that the aligners are working — they're applying gentle force to move your teeth. The discomfort is generally much less than with traditional braces and can usually be managed with over-the-counter pain relief if needed.

How long does Invisalign treatment take?

Treatment time varies depending on the complexity of your case. Simple cases may take as little as six months, while more complex treatments typically take 12–18 months. Your ClinCheck treatment plan will provide an estimated timeline specific to your situation.

Will Invisalign affect my speech?

Some patients notice a very slight lisp when they first start wearing aligners. This almost always resolves within a few days as your tongue adapts. Most people find that any speech effect is so minor that others don't notice it.

Can I eat normally with Invisalign?

Yes. One of Invisalign's biggest advantages is that you remove the aligners to eat, so there are no dietary restrictions at all. Eat whatever you like — just brush your teeth before putting the aligners back in.

How do I clean my aligners?

Rinse aligners under lukewarm water and gently brush them with a soft toothbrush. Avoid hot water (it can warp the plastic) and coloured or scented soaps. Invisalign also offers cleaning crystals designed specifically for their aligners.

What if I lose an aligner?

Contact us and we'll advise on the best course of action. In most cases, you can either move to the next aligner in the sequence or temporarily go back to the previous set while a replacement is ordered. Our Blue Diamond status means we have strong support from Invisalign for situations like this.

Can I see what my teeth will look like after treatment?

Yes. Our ClinCheck software creates a 3D simulation of your complete treatment, showing your projected results before you start. It's one of the most compelling aspects of Invisalign — you can see your future smile before committing.

Is Invisalign as effective as traditional braces?

For the vast majority of orthodontic cases, yes. Invisalign can treat mild, moderate, and many complex cases with comparable effectiveness to traditional braces. However, some highly complex cases may still benefit from braces or a combination approach. We'll always recommend the treatment that will deliver the best result for your specific situation.

Can I play sport with Invisalign?

Yes. Unlike traditional braces — where a blow to the mouth can drive brackets into the soft tissue causing lacerations — Invisalign aligners are smooth plastic. You can wear your aligners during sport (and should, to maintain your wear time). For contact sports, a mouthguard is still recommended over the top of your aligners. We can advise on the best approach for your specific sport.

What if I have existing dental work (crowns, veneers, implants)?

Invisalign can usually be used alongside existing dental work, though the treatment plan may need to account for crowns, veneers, or implants. Attachments (the small tooth-coloured dots that help aligners grip) may bond differently to dental restorations than to natural enamel, and dental implants cannot be moved by aligners. We'll assess your specific situation during consultation and advise on any adjustments needed.

What happens if I don't wear my retainer after treatment?

Teeth have a natural tendency to shift back toward their original positions — a process called relapse. Retainers prevent this. If you stop wearing your retainer, you risk losing some or all of the improvement achieved during treatment. Retainers are a lifelong commitment to maintaining your result, but they're simple, comfortable, and become part of your routine very quickly.
