Patients often endure years of jaw pain, headaches, clicking joints and disrupted sleep before receiving a proper diagnosis. The reason is simple - TMD rarely has a single cause, and effective treatment requires expertise that no general dental practice can provide alone.

Why TMD Is Not a Simple Problem TMD involves the temporomandibular joint, the surrounding muscles, and the way your teeth come together. But the condition frequently overlaps with sleep-disordered breathing, chronic bruxism (grinding) and musculoskeletal tension in the head, neck and shoulders. A patient might present with jaw pain, but investigation reveals they also grind heavily at night, have an obstructed airway contributing to poor sleep, and carry significant tension through the cervical spine and facial muscles. Treating only one element - say, fitting a night guard - addresses a symptom while the underlying causes continue. This is why TMD treatment requires a multi-specialist approach that general practice simply cannot deliver.

The Smile Solutions TMD Approach For complex cases requiring specialist multi-disciplinary care, your Core Dental dentist can refer you to Smile Solutions and the Collins Street Specialist Centre, where TMD is treated through a combined protocol that brings together multiple disciplines in one location.

In-House Osteopathy Rachel Smith, the centre's in-house osteopath, works directly with the dental team to address the musculoskeletal component of TMD. Jaw dysfunction rarely exists in isolation from the neck, shoulders and upper back. Having osteopathic treatment in the same building as dental specialist care means your treatment is genuinely coordinated, not just parallel.

EMG Analysis - Beyond Botox Many practitioners offer Botox injections as a TMD treatment. While muscle relaxation has its place, the Collins Street Specialist Centre uses electromyography (EMG) analysis to map exactly which muscles are overactive and to what degree. This diagnostic precision means treatment targets the actual problem rather than masking symptoms.

Laser Therapy Therapeutic laser treatment reduces inflammation and promotes healing in the temporomandibular joint and surrounding tissues. Combined with specialist assessment and osteopathic care, laser therapy forms part of an integrated treatment protocol.

Sleep Assessment The connection between TMD and sleep-disordered breathing is well established. Patients who grind at night often do so as a response to airway compromise during sleep. The centre's approach includes screening for sleep issues and coordinating with sleep physicians where indicated.
